


The “70s” – Routes to the North

These routes are of interest because they mostly travel along Calle 64, closer to the communities of Santiago and Santa Ana, and then head north. Whether you’re going north or somewhere closer like Paseo 60 or the Slow Food Market, when you’re standing at a stop waiting for one bus and another shows up, it’s good to know if that one will do as well.

Centro to Circuito Colonias




These six routes are identical south of Circuito, except their first stops. They go north on C. 64 and return on C. 62.

Up C. 56 and down C. 62.

Up. C. 64 and down C. 66.

The *paraderos* are different.

Circuito Colonias to the North



These turn west at Sam’s Club, just past Home Depot. R75 goes all the way to Dzitya.

This turns west at Siglo XXI, but stops at the back doors of Costco and Galerías.

These stop at all of the high-lights of the North – Costco, Chedraui, The Harbor, etc.

These all go west through Chuburna and Francisco de Montejo.

The blue-ribbon winners for heading to Costco, Siglo XXI, The Harbor, etc. from stops on Calle 64 are R73 & R74. Two good alternatives are R72 (stops at Siglo XXI and the back of Costco and Galerías), and R70, passing by Parque La Plancha.
